2.	Trace the journey of Abram on a map (11:27 – 12:9). Where did he start? What place did he and his father "settle" until Terah died? What was the first place Abram arrived at in Canaan? Next place? Final area Abram came to in Canaan? What significant action does Abraham take at his stopping points in Canaan? Who is with Abram during these journeys? Name their relationship to Abram. Read Hebrews 11:8-10. Why would it take "faith" for Abram to do these things? What does this reveal to us about what "faith" is?	
3.	A famine happens in Canaan. Where does Abram go? What does he ask Sarai to do for him? What happens to her? What is the LORD's reaction to this?
